### Southeastern "Bottle-Neck" Courses

Attached is a report identifying potential "bottle-neck" courses for Southeastern freshmen. The report is based on a report prepared annually for the Supplemental Instruction program at Southeastern. This program works with departments to identify courses with a high rate of unsatisfactory grades and provide additional tutoring opportunities for those courses. An unsatisfactory grade is defined as a grade of D, F, U, or W.

The attached report includes only courses which met the following criteria:

1. 100 level or lower
2. Offered in Fall 2010 and Fall 2011
3. An enrollment of at least 25 students

The courses which met each of those criteria are presented in order of the highest percent of unsatisfactory grades to the lowest percent.

In Fall 2010, there were 9 courses where 50% or more of the students had unsatisfactory grades. In Fall 2011, there were only 8 courses; MATH 162 is no longer on the list. Four of the five courses with the highest percent of unsatisfactory grades were math courses (155, 92A, 155A, 165) and the other course was CHEM 122.
