Addendum to: Memorandum of Understanding

Northshore Technical Community College and Southeastern Louisiana University Connect to Success Program

Signed November 29, 2012

Expanded Course Offerings for the Connect to Success Program and Inclusion of Students Potentially Admissible to Southeastern Louisiana University

Effective Spring 2014, Northshore Technical Community College (NTCC) will expand its General Education course offerings to students in the *Connect to Success Program* and begin enrolling in the program students that are potentially admissible to Southeastern Louisiana University (Southeastern). A current list of NTCC courses offered as part of the *Connect to Success Program* and the Southeastern equivalencies is included in Appendix A of this addendum.

Course offerings will be available to students at Southeastern's North Campus facility, St. Tammany Center and the Livingston Literacy Center. Laboratory course offerings will be restricted to the St. Tammany Center and Livingston Parish Literacy and Technology Center.

For a laboratory course, NTCC students will pay the same course fee as Southeastern students. NTCC will then transfer those funds to Southeastern.

Until such time that NTCC faculty can begin designing their own experiments, purchasing laboratory materials and disposing of hazardous waste:

- Southeastern will provide Laboratory Coordinators to set up both the Biology and Chemistry Labs at the St. Tammany Center and Livingston Center. (This will be covered by a portion of the course fee charged to students)
- Chemical waste will be returned to Southeastern and disposed of according to existing protocols.
- Course content (e.g. experiments) is to be the same as that of the corresponding Southeastern courses while Southeastern faculty are serving as instructors of record for the courses.

NTCC will be responsible for replacing any existing laboratory equipment that is damaged or destroyed during use.

Regular classroom rates will continue to be charged at a rate previously agreed upon by both parties.

Laboratory space will incur an increased charge due to waste disposal and routine inspections required by Southeastern.

LPN-to-BS in Nursing Articulation—Practical Nursing Connection Program

Effective Spring 2014, physical space and resources at Southeastern will be utilized by NTCC to support the articulated transfer of LPN-to-BS students.

Southeastern typically has 25-60 highly qualified students per semester that are not admitted into the RN clinical portion of its BS in Nursing program. This partnership will provide those students an opportunity to complete specified courses at NTCC that upon successful completion would render them eligible, possibly in as little as one year, to be placed in the clinical portion of the RN program at Southeastern without having to reapply.

Students not selected to enter the clinical portion of the BS in Nursing program at Southeastern may be enrolled in NTCC's accelerated LPN program. If they enroll in the courses as specified and offered, within one year, rather than the typical eighteen (18) months, these students will be eligible to sit for the LPN licensure exam. At that time students will then be eligible to articulate as LPN-BS students to Southeastern and potentially be placed in clinical courses where positions are available.

Furthermore:

- LPN-to-BS in Nursing students have the same rights and privileges as students in the Connect to Success Program.
- LPN-to-BS in Nursing students, due to their classification, will have parking privileges in Upperclassmen areas whereas *Connect to Success Program* students are restricted to Freshman parking areas.
- LPN-to-BS in Nursing students are in no way guaranteed an LPN License from NTCC or a position in the BS in Nursing program as a result of participating in this program.
